SDG FACT SHEET 2020

The global SDG indicators play a very vital role in the drive for timely and reliable data. This is the foundation of the 2030 Agenda's accountability mechanism. They serve in measuring progress of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and also effectively prompt countries to take action to achieve the SDG targets.

There are 232 SDG indicators and only 201 are applicable in the Ugandan context. This SDG fact sheet complements Uganda's 2020 Voluntary National Review Report. It provides a snapshot of the main characteristics of each of the 92 indicators on which Uganda reported. This shows that reporting on progress is less than half way and it calls for more efforts in data production for SDGs.

The Government and partners like UN Women are working together, through the Uganda Bureau of Statistics to generate, disseminate and use national data, as well as integrate SDG indicators into the national monitoring frameworks.

This Fact sheet has been produced by the SDG Secretariat in the Office of the Prime Minister with support from UN Women. It will provides precise information to national stakeholders to tackle the main constraints faced in reporting SDG indicators, thus raising the reporting rates and ultimately contributing to furthering the achievement of the SDGs in Uganda.








Death rate due to road traffic injuries





























Tax Revenue to GDP Ratio






Volume of remittances (in United States dollars) as a proportion of total GDP
